About Host Organisation

The Environment Protection Training and Research Institute (EPTRI) was setup in 1982 by the Government of Andhra Pradesh with the support of Government of India and technical collaboration from Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency - SIDA to extend training, consultancy and applied research services in the area of environment protection to industry, regulatory bodies, government, non-governmental organizations (NGOs) etc. ENVIS center was established at EPTRI in 1994 on Eastern Ghats Ecology. This is one of the most environmentally threatened regions in India with its unique flora, fauna, microbes, water, soil, geology, the tribal population, etc



Activities of the Centre

The main activity of EPTRI-ENVIS is to collect, store and disseminate information on Eastern Ghats that may be of interest to the line departments, scientists, researchers, industries, non-governmental organisations and other stakeholders.

- Update the bibliographic database on Eastern Ghats.
- A list of experts on ecology of the Eastern Ghats on Ecology was prepared and database on the same was developed.
- A resources database is under preparation covering a range of about 1500 parameters of the recommended UNEP GRID Format.
- Three issues of the Newsletter “The Eastern Ghats” were released .
- As a follow up action on the charter for Eastern Ghats Conservation, a proposal entitled “Strengthen the Environmental Monitoring and Assessment Activities for the Eastern Ghats of India” through EPTRI was prepared and submitted to UNEP for UNEP-EPTRI joint project of capacity building.
- At EPTRI a National Seminar on Conservation of Eastern Ghats was held on March 24-26, 2002 at Tirupati as a sequel to the Seminar held in 1998 at Visakhapatnam.
- A website was launched (<http://www.envis-eptri.org>) for ENVIS - EPTRI that was uploaded on January, 2002.
- The repository of information is thus being continuously strengthened and acts as a referral Centre.

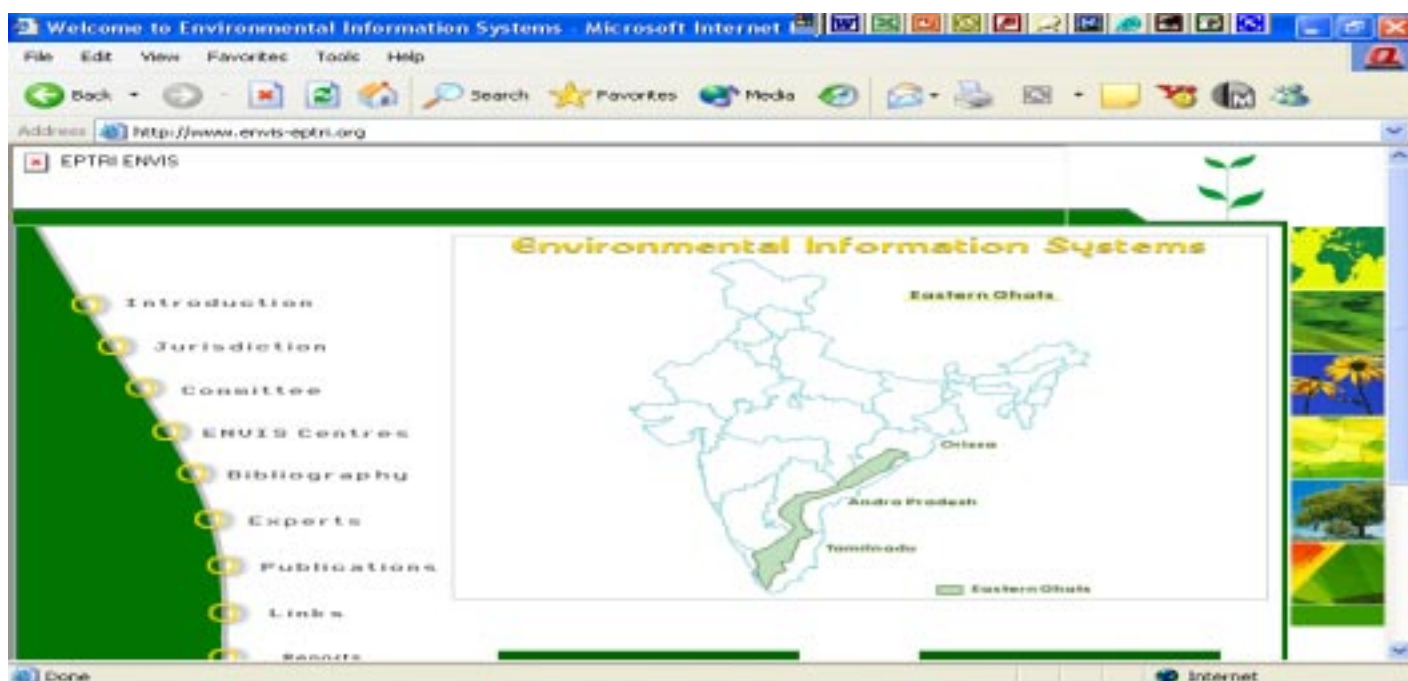
Services
