About the Host Organisation

Indian School of Mines was established in the year 1926 at Dhanbad by the Government of India to train mining engineers and geologists. It has become a Deemed University in 1967 under the UGC Act, 1956. New branches of academic programs have been added to its traditional departments and new departments have been established to cater to other industries in addition to the mineral industry. Centre of Mining Environment at ISM was set up in March 1987 under the scheme of “Centre of Excellence” of MOEF. Subsequently ENVIS Centre on “Environmental Problems of Mining” was set up in 1991.



Activities of the Centre

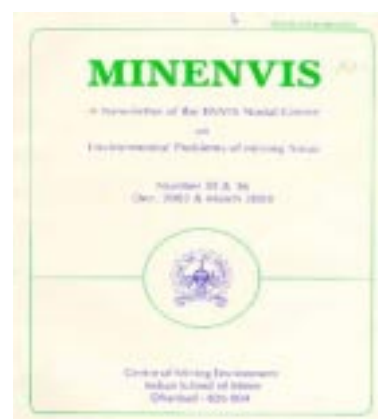
- Collect, collate, store and disseminate information related to mining environment
