### About Host Organisation

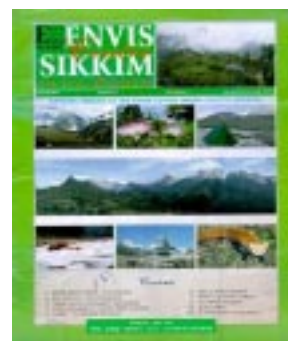

### ○ **Abstracting Services**

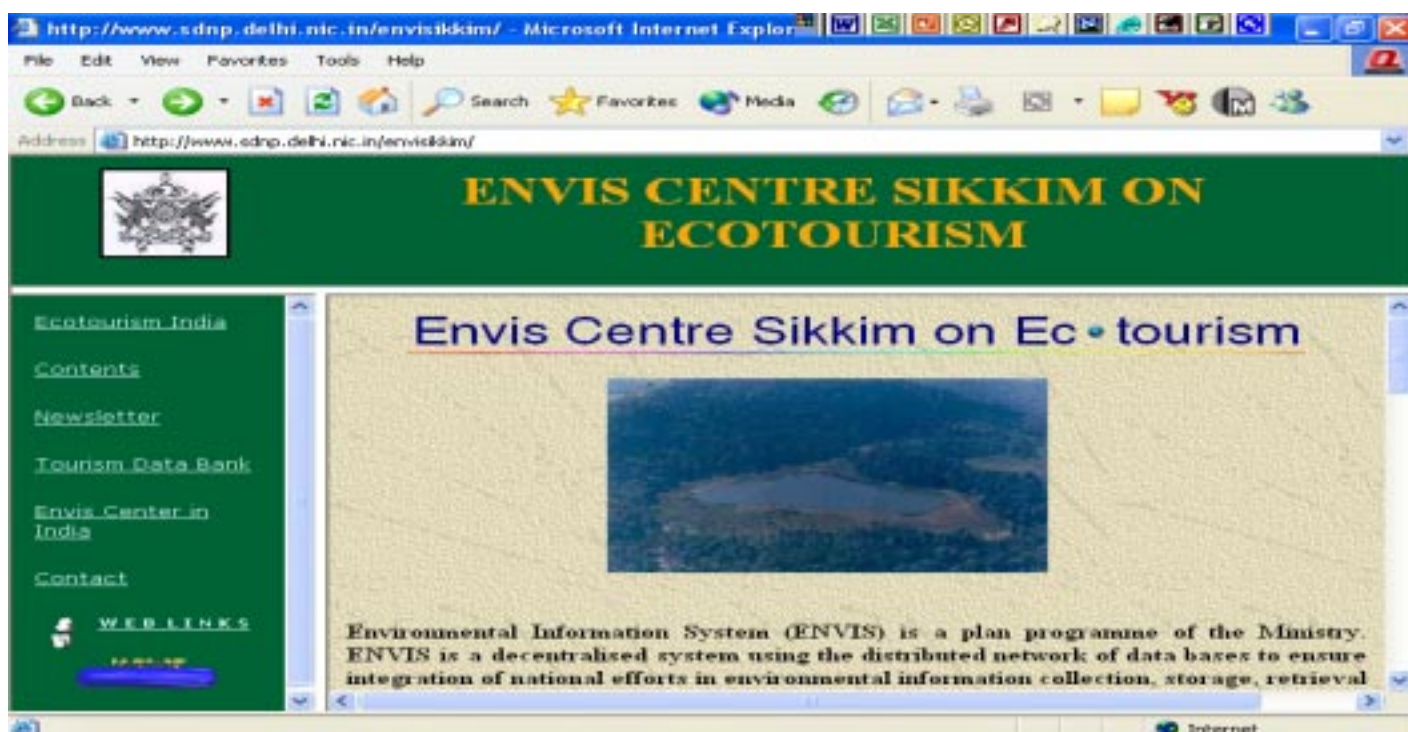
- ◆ The service is being currently provided and will be continued as a printed version. Around 5000 bibliographic references on animal biodiversity and ecology have been stored for catering service to the users.

### ○ **Query Answer Services**

- ◆ The ENVIS centre responds to various requests for information from several user groups on the subject of “Ecotourism”. During the year, on an average 150 queries are answered.
