

**Decisions of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change with respect to import and export of hazardous waste under the Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008 as approved by Secretary (E&F) on the basis of recommendation of the 56<sup>th</sup> meeting of Expert Committee held during 11<sup>th</sup> March 2015 for appraisal of such applications.**

**AGENDA ITEM 2.1:IMPORT OF ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC ASSEMBLIES ETC**

**2.1.1 M/s Safran Engineering Services India P. Ltd., Bangalore (No.23-8/2015-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended the import (1 Kg of Electronic Board (Rheostate Simulator Hardware PCB-pre-programmed for repair).

**2.1.2 M/s Semi-Conductor Laboratory, Lucknow (No.23-174/2013-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended the import(3 refurbished RF Generators and RF match Unit for their use).

**2.1.3 M/s Span Healthcare P. Ltd., New Delhi (No.23-229/2012-HSMD):**

**Decision:** Since some of the information was not available in documents submitted by the applicant, the Committee suggested that the applicant may be asked to come for presentation.

**2.1.4 M/s Tescre Software Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore (No.23-31/2015-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended the import (39.89 Kg of Dell Server) on the condition that the item will be sent back after the R&D work is over within three years.

**2.1.5 M/s Honeywell Technology Solutions Lab Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore (No.23-26/2014-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended the import (290 used electronic goods).

**2.1.6 M/s Applied Materials India P. Ltd., Bangalore (NO.23-116/2014-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The items (03 nos. used electrical/electronic goods) are being imported from their principals abroad for R&D work and will be re-exported within five years. The year of manufacture was reported to be 2011. The Committee recommended the import.

**2.1.7 M/s Nokia Solutions Ltd, New Delhi (No.23-69/2011-HSMD):**

**Decision:**The Committee recommended the import (05+02+18+46+338+754+62+432+7480+7402 nos. of Networking Equipment with accessories and used Hardware and spare parts/Not repairable units).

**2.1.8 M/s Keysight Technologies India Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore (No.23-150/2014-HSMD):**

**Decision:** There are two applications:

1. 300 items which are being imported as replacement of defective components of equipment supplied to various customers are recommended for import and the defective components will be re-exported.
2. In respect of 642 items which are proposed to be imported for supply to various customers and will not be re-exported, it is observed that CEC from the exporting country has not been provided. The applicant has been asked to obtain the CEC before the application is considered.

**2.1.9 M/s Barco Electronic Systems Pvt. Ltd., Noida (23-155/2012- HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended the import (4,000+300 nos. of electrical & Electronic items).

**2.1.10 M/s Yogiraj, Vikaspur, New Delhi (No.23-36/2015-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee observed that the items (7 CCTV Cameras) have already been imported. However, in view of the first time import and being for personal use, the Committee recommended the import.

**2.1.11 M/s Lam Research (India) Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore (No.23-2/2015-HSMD):**

**Decision:** Since the items have already been imported without prior permission, it is an illegal import. Moreover, the CEC is also not attached. Therefore, the Committee recommended re-export.

**2.1.12 M/s Century Textiles Inds Ltd., Nainital (Uttarakhand) (No.23-27/2015-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended the import (01 no. of Refurbished Colorimetric Titration cell).

**2.1.13 M/s Shields Environmental Services P. Ltd., (No.23-228/2013-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee deferred the decision on the case due to pending Authorization on E-Waste and undertaking from the applicant regarding taking it back from customer.

**2.1.14 M/s HCL Technologies Ltd., Noida (No.23-77/2011-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee was informed that the items (7 used equipment with accessories) have already been imported. Since the applicant has been earlier importing number of used equipment with permission from this Ministry and the Committee was not convinced of the reason given by the representative for not following the procedure of obtaining prior permission of the Ministry in this case, the Committee is of the view that the items should be re-exported since the import is illegal.

**2.1.15 M/s Samsung India Electronics Pvt. Ltd., Noida (No.23-86/2011-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended the import (45 unit and 11 set of used calibration of equipment).

**2.1.16 M/s V-Tech Communications, Faridabad (No.23-119/2014-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee, on the basis of the undertaking that the five used telephone test and measurement equipment will be re-exported within a period of three years, reconsidered the case. This being the first time, the Committee recommended the import.

**2.1.17 M/s Avaya India Pvt. Ltd., Pune (No.23-214/2013-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee observed that all these items (48+16+17 used/second hand capital goods) are very old (1994-1996 make) and most of them are now obsolete. The applicant has not given any undertaking that they will be sent back once they are non-functional. In view of this, the committee did not recommend the import.

**2.1.18 M/s Maxlinear Technologies P Ltd. Bangalore (No. 23-70/2014):**

**Decision:** Since the documents submitted by the applicant did not contain the requisite information, the Committee suggested the applicant may be called for presentation.

**2.1.19 M/s H.P. Limited Gurgaon (23-31/2011-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee was informed that these items (two Indigo r5500 Digital Printing press) are of 2009 make and have been refurbished in 2014. The residual life is reported to be 10 years. Moreover, the sale of these items will be with adequate warranty for servicing by the applicant. In view of this the Committee recommended the import.

**AGENDA ITEM NO. 2.2.: IMPORT OF BATTERY/LEAD SCRAP/TITANIUM SCRAP ETC.:**

**2.2.1 M/s Stalwart Alloys India P. Ltd., Kurukshetra (Haryana) (No.23-268/2014-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The applicant was invited for presentation; the applicant did not turn up. The Committee therefore deferred the decision.

**2.2.2 M/s Gravita Metal Inc., Kathua (J&K) (No.23-38/2015-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended 1200 MT Lead Scrap (Radio, Racks, Relay, Rakes, Rents and Rails).

**2.2.3 M/s Jain Metal Rolling Mills, Thiruvallur (No.23-130/2014-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended 6,000 MT of Lead Scrap (Radio, Ropes, Racks, Rails, Rents and Relay) for recovery of lead.

**2.2.4 M/s Trichy Metals, and Alloys, District Trichy (23-33/2015-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended import of 400 MT of Lead Scrap (Radio, Ropes, Racks, Rails, Rents and Relay) for recovery of lead.

### **2.2.5 M/s Mittal Pigments Pvt. Ltd., Kota (No.23-30/2009-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended 5000 MT of Lead Scrap (Radio, Ropes, Rails, Relay, Rents and Rakes) for recovery of lead.

### **2.2.6 M/s Jammu Pigments Ltd., Kathua (J&K) (No.23-58/2009-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended the import of 1700 MT of Lead Scrap (Radio, Ropes, Rails, Relay, Rents and Rakes) for recovery of lead.

### **2.2.7 M/s Chloride Alloys India Ltd., Kolkata (No.23-153/2014-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended import of 30,000 MT of Lead Scrap (ISRI Code: Radio/Rails/Racks/Relay and Ropes).

## **AGENDA NO.2.3: IMPORT OF RUBBER SCRAP ETC.**

### **2.3.1 M/s Tinna Rubber and Infrastructure Ltd., New Delhi (NO.5-22/2010-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended the import of 5000 MT of old/ used tyres (Cut in 2, 3 pcs.) for manufacturing of crumb rubber for Wada Plant (Maharashtra).

### **2.3.2 M/s A.K. Rubber, Valsad (Gujarat) (NO.23-40/2015-HSMD):**

**Decision:** Based on the video presentation, the Committee recommended 800 MT of old/used rubber tyre scrap/Tube Scrap non-radial/radial tyres scrap for manufacturing of crumb rubber. The Committee also suggested to the applicant to incorporate adequate APC systems for controlling the dust and fiber emission. On submitting evidence of installing of these systems the import of further quantity 2000 MT would be considered.

### **2.3.3 M/s Gennext Hitec Rubber Vellore (No.5-28/2014-HSMD):**

**Decision:** On the request of the applicant, the case is deferred.

### **2.3.4 M/s Dashmesh Rubber Industries (P) Ltd., Valsad (Gujarat) (No.23-39/2015-HSMD):**

**Decision:** Based on the video presentation, the Committee recommended 200 MT of old/used rubber tyre scrap/Tube Scrap non-radial/radial tyres scrap for manufacturing of crumb rubber. The Committee also suggested to the applicant to incorporate adequate APC systems for controlling the dust and fiber emission. On submitting evidence of installing of these systems the import of further quantity 300 MT would be considered.

### **2.3.5 M/s Novartis Energy P. Ltd., Nagpur (No.23-7/2015-HSMD)**

**Decision:** The Committee observed that the applicant had earlier been given permission for import of 2000 MT of used tyres. The Committee is of the view that before further quantity is recommended a site visit should be made. The Chairman, Expert Committee was requested to make a site visit since the site is near Mumbai.

### **2.3.6 M/s Shakambari Rubber P. Ltd., Kolkata (No.5-35/2014-HSMD):**

**Decision:** From the video shown by the applicant, the Committee made the following observations:

1. There is no dust and fiber emission control system.
2. No safety systems like guards on moving equipment have been provided and no PPEs appliances have been provided to the workers.
3. The housekeeping is very poor.

In view of this, the Committee suggested to the applicant to incorporate adequate pollution control and safety systems before the application could be considered for import.

**2.3.7 M/s S.R. Reclamation (P) Ltd., Ludhiana (Punjab) (no.23-43/2015-HSMD):**

**Decision:** Based on the video presentation, the Committee recommended import of 1500 MT of used rubber tyres and tubes with one cut, multi-cut, press, baled and shredded for manufacturing of rubber crumb/reclaim rubber.

**2.3.8 M/s Nine Corporation, Jhabua (M.P.) (No.23-233/2014-HSMD):**

**Decision:** Based on the video presentation, the Committee recommended import of 9500 MT of used rubber tyres & Tubes with one cut multi-cut Press and baled and shredded for manufacturing of crumb rubber.

**2.3.9 M/s S& J Granulate Solution (P) Ltd., Vapi (Gujarat) (No.5-19/2011-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee recommended import of 16000 MT old and used rubber tyres scrap (Cut/shredded/baled press) for manufacturing of crumb rubber.

**2.3.10 M/s Markap Resources Pvt. Ltd., Abu Road (No.23-259/2014-HSMD).**

**Decision:** The applicant was earlier granted permission 6000 MT of cut tyres. The units was also visited by a Member of the Committee who confirmed that the plant layout is very good and have installed all the plant and machinery commensurate with the capacity given in Consent to Operate (CTO). The Committee now recommends 14000 MT of cut tyres.

**2.3.11 Sree Shakti rubber, Andhra Pradesh (F.No. 23-168/2014-HSMD)**

**Decision:** During inspection by Zonal Office, CPCB, Bangalore certain improvements have been suggested and the applicant has been asked to carry installation of the required system of fugitive emission control. The case will be reconsidered on receipt of confirmation of the installation.

**2.3.12 EPS International, Surat, Gujarat (No.23-5/2015-HSMD)**

**Decision:** Based on the video presentation, the Committee recommended import 5500 MT of used rubber tyres/ tubes in one cut/ multicut/ pressed and baled/ shredded for manufacturing of crumb rubber powder.

**AGENDA NO.2.4: IMPORT OF OIL**

**2.4.1 M/s ABC Organics & Chemicals, Bharuch (Gujarat) (23-42/2011-HSMD):**

**Decision:** In respect of the proposed import the applicant is not able to confirm that the used oil will meet the specifications as per Schedule 5 A of the HW Rules, 2008. The applicant has therefore been advised to get a certificate from the supplier that the used oil will meet the specifications.

### **Agenda No.3: Export of E-waste**

#### **3.1.1 M/s Trishyiraya Recycling India Pvt. Ltd., Chennai (No.23-4/2005-HSMD):**

**Decision:** The Committee observed that last year the applicant has exported about 400 MT of E-waste (mainly PCBs). Moreover, registration is for total 4500 MT of E-waste. The Committee recommended the export of 1000 MT of E-waste.

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
