

## **Comments on Safety Assessment Report of Sub-Committee on GE Mustard**

There have been few representations regarding extension of time limit and publishing the full dossier on genetically engineered (GE) mustard on website.

As per the recommendations of the sub-committee and after taking into consideration of international practices, the document “Assessment of Food and Environmental Safety (AFES)” for Environmental release of GE Mustard (Brassica juncea) hybrid DMH-11 and use of parental events (Varuna bn3.6 and EH2 modbs 2.99) for development of new generation hybrids is available for public comments for 30 days only. The last date of receiving comments is October 5, 2016. The full dossier is available for review in the GEAC Secretariat at MoEFCC.
