

**Decision of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change with respect to import and export of hazardous and other waste under the provisions of Hazardous and other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 as approved by the Competent Authority on the basis of 158<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Expert Committee (EC) held on 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2026.**

### **PROCEEDINGS**

158<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Expert Committee (EC) for Appraisal of Applications for Import/Export of hazardous and other wastes with reference to Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 as amended from time to time held on 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2026 in Hybrid Mode under the chairmanship of Shri Sudhir Srivastava.

**Opening Remarks of the Chairman:** The Chairman extended welcome to members and other participants and requested to start the proceeding as per the agenda adopted for this meeting.

**Consideration of Proposals:** The EC considered the proposals as per agenda adopted for the meeting. The details of deliberations held and decisions taken in the meeting are as under:

#### **AGENDA NO. 1. IMPORT OF LEAD SCRAP/BATTERIES SCRAP** **(BASEL NO. B1020/B1090/A1160)**

##### **1.1. M/s POCL Enterprises Limited, Chengalpattu, Tamil Nadu (F.No.23-203/2015-HSMD)**

The application (App ID-SW2403548563-M014\_D001\_A304-1785848804960) pertains to import of 20,000 MT of Lead Scrap/Battery Scrap (ISRI Code: Radio, Ropes, Racks, Rakes, Rails, Rents, Relay, Roses, Reels, Lead Grids, Lead Paste, Lead Dross, Lead Scrap in crushed or powder form, Lead Flakes and powder) (B1020). The applicant has furnished Form 5, Justification for import, Process flow chart indicating adequate pollution control equipment, Lead analysis report in soil, air, water, stack and blood of the workers. The Consent No. 2208142653065 dated 04<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 is valid up to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2027 and authorization No. 22HFC46289840 dated 23<sup>rd</sup> December, 2022 is valid up to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2027. The consented capacity Lead of 99.97/99.98- purity – 800 MT/ month, Lead wire, Flats and Profiles -100 MT/month, Lead alloys of calcium/antimony/Selenium/arsenic/Tin – 1250 T/M, Lead Sub Oxide -250 T/month. The date of establishment is 05<sup>th</sup> May, 2005. The Actual date of operation is 01<sup>st</sup> September, 2007. The production in last FY (2025- 26) was 22,484.68 MT. The export was 11,429.17 MT for FY (2025-26). The domestic purchase was 6,945.31 MT out of 41,618.70 MT and Lead Dross, Scrap Battery Terminals, Plates, Remelted Lead, Unrefined Lead Ingots – a. Domestic Purchase is 6,784.37 MT, b. Import purchase is 17,726.72 MT during FY 2025–26, out of which 1,178 MT of Remelted Lead (RML) was purchased from units that had been granted import permission by this Ministry. During FY 2025-2026, Input Tax Credit carried forward from FY 2024-25 is Rs. 1,16,91,244/-, Total Input GST is Rs.1,55,48,43,450 /-, Total output GST is Rs. 1,62,35,48,477/-, Net GST paid through ITC Credit is Rs. 1,56,65,34,694/-. The previous permission was given for the import of 17,582 MT of Lead Scrap/Battery Scarp vide letter dated 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2025. The site visit was conducted by CPCB on 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2024.

**Recommendation:** Based on the information and details submitted by the applicant, the EC after deliberation on the proposal recommended import of 17,663 MT of Lead Scrap/Battery Scrap (ISRI Code: Radio, Ropes,

**Racks, Rakes, Rails, Rents, Relay, Roses, Reels, Lead Grids, Lead Paste, Lead Dross, Lead Scrap in crushed or powder form, Lead Flakes and powder) (B1020).**

**1.2. M/s Pondy Oxides And Chemicals Limited, Kancheepuram, Tamil Nadu (F.No.23-87/2009-HSMD)**

The application (App ID-SW7475888608-M014\_D001\_A304-1782729452528) pertains to import of 64,000 MT of Lead Scrap/Battery Scrap (ISRI Code: Radio, Racks, Rails, Rakes, Relay, Ropes, Rents, Roses, Rink, Rono, Rains and Roper and Lead Grinds, Lead Paste, Lead Dross, Lead Scrap in crushed or powder form) (B1020/A1160). The applicant has furnished Form 5, Justification for import, Process flow chart indicating adequate pollution control equipment, Lead analysis report in soil, air, water, stack and blood of the workers. The Consent No. 2204243155310 dated 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2022 is valid up to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2027 and authorization CCA No. 23HFC8187115 Dated 02<sup>nd</sup> January, 2023 is valid up to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2027. The consented capacity of Lead Metal and Alloys is 48000 MT/ Annum. The date of establishment is 05<sup>th</sup> May, 2005. The Actual date of operation is 01<sup>st</sup> September, 2007. The production in last FY (2025-26) was 47,681 MT. The export was 31,872 MT for FY (2025-26). The domestic purchase was 14,608 MT and the quantity Remelted Lead Domestic purchase is 14,585 MT, Battery Scrap Domestic purchase is 23 MT, Total is 14,608 MT during FY 2025–26 and 3,234 MT of Remelted Lead (RML) was purchased from units that had been granted import permission by this Ministry. During FY 2025-2026, Opening balance of GST is Rs 1,14,62,388 /-, Input claimed is Rs 2,40,28,22,206 /-, Input utilized is Rs 2,40,98,92,984/- & Closing Balance is Rs 43,91,610/-The previous permission was given for the import of 31,985 MT of Lead Scrap/Battery Scrap *vide* letter dated 13<sup>th</sup> November, 2025. The site visit was conducted by CPCB on 27<sup>th</sup> January, 2023 and for Rink facility in July, 2023.

**Recommendation:** Based on the information and details submitted by the applicant, the EC after deliberation on the proposal recommended import of 49,802 MT of Lead Scrap/Batteries Scrap (ISRI Code: Radio, Racks, Rails, Rakes, Relay, Ropes, Rents, Roses and Lead Grinds, Lead Paste, Lead Dross, Lead Scrap in crushed or powder form (B1020), Roper, Rono & Rains (A1160) with not more than 2% of liquid/electrolyte by weight in a given lot/consignment/container and Rink (A1160). The quantity of import of Rink will be limited to 50% of the total import quantity recommended. The import of Basel No. A1160 is allowed subject to the Prior Informed Consent (PIC) of the exporting country. Further, 50% of the aforesaid recommended quantity (i.e. 24,901 MT) may be granted now and the rest quantity (i.e.24,901) may be granted after submission of site visit report by CPCB stating compliance of SOP without referring the application to EC again.

**1.3. M/s Rajdev Industries, Jalandhar, Punjab (F. No. 23/88/2022-HSM)**

The application (App ID-SW2403245155-M014\_D001\_A304-1783323917124) pertains to import of 5,000 MT of Lead Scrap/Battery Scrap (ISRI Code: Radio, Racks, Rails, Relay, Ropes, Rents and Rakes) (B1020). The applicant has furnished Form 5, Justification for import, Process flow chart indicating adequate pollution control equipment, Lead analysis report in soil, air, water, stack and blood of the workers. The Consent No. CTOA/Varied/JAL1/2024/27105434 dated 05<sup>th</sup> November, 2024 is valid upto 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2029 and authorization No. HWM/Fresh/JAL1/2024/27151796 Dated 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2024 is valid up to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2029. The consented capacity of Lead Acid Battery Plates and Lead Scrap

(Dry): 5000 MT/Year, Lead Ingots: 5000 MT/Year & Lead Ingots is 150 MT/M. The date of establishment is 08<sup>th</sup> April, 2020. The Actual date of operation is 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2020. The production in last FY (2025-26) was 4170 MT. The export was Nil for FY (2025-26). The domestic purchase was 1,810 MT out of 4,649 MT. Procured domestically lead scrap only for manufacturing Lead Ingots during FY 2025–26. During FY 2025-2026, Gross GST amount is 10,83,45,260.00/-, The Input Tax Credit (ITC) details is 9,34,50,046.00/- & Net GST Payable Amount (NO LAIBILITY PENDING) is 1,48,95,214.00/-. The previous permission was given for the import of 2,168 MT of Lead Scrap/Battery Scarp *vide* letter dated 16<sup>th</sup> May 2025. The site visit was conducted by CPCB on 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2022.

**Recommendation:** Based on the information and details submitted by the applicant, the EC after deliberation on the proposal recommended import of 2,316 MT of Lead Scrap/Battery Scrap (ISRI Code: Radio, Racks, Rails, Relay, Ropes, Rents and Rakes) (B1020). Further, 50% of the aforesaid recommended quantity (i.e. 1,158 MT) may be granted now and the rest quantity (i.e. 1,158 MT) may be granted after submission of site visit report by CPCB stating compliance of SOP without referring the application to EC again.

EC further recommended that details of domestic procurement of raw material with proper bifurcation i.e. battery scrap, lead scrap and Remelted lead (RML) purchased along with details of the company from where the same was purchased may be obtained from the applicant. In case such sellers have already received import permission on account of the remelted lead produced by them, the eligible quantity may be correspondingly reduced. Permission may be given only after satisfactory reply for the eligible quantity so determined, without referring to the EC.

#### **1.4. M/s Sage Green Industries Private Limited (Former Sealine Biochem Private Limited), Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh (New Application)**

The application (App ID- SW0072342821-M014\_D001\_A304-1782883014827) pertains to import of 6500 MT of Used Lithium- ion battery Scrap (B1090). The applicant has furnished Form 5, Justification for import, Process flow chart indicating adequate pollution control equipment, Lead analysis report in soil, air, water, stack and blood of the workers. The Consent No. CCA No. AW-62955 (Name change) & CCA expansion dated 11/09/2025 Dated 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2026 is valid up to 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2030. The consented capacity of Black mass is 5400 M.T., Chemical processing of Black mass (R &D purpose only) is 600.00 Kg/Day.

**Recommendation:** Based on the information and details submitted by the applicant, the EC after deliberation on the proposal recommended 500 MT of Used Lithium- ion battery Scrap (B1090) (as per the decision taken during 142<sup>nd</sup> meeting of EC held on 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2025), subject to the condition that at least 60% of the Black mass produced during the Financial Year (FY) should be further recycled/refined within the country to get critical mineral/precious metals/rare earth metals. The EC also advised the unit to make vigorous efforts to procure domestic waste, so as to have a mix of both imported and domestic purchases. Further, the above-recommended quantity may be granted after submission of site visit report by CPCB stating compliance of SOP without referring to the EC.

**1.5 M/s Eswari Global Metal Industries Limited – Unit-1, Mangaluru, Karnataka (F.No. 23-31/2009-HSMD)**

The applicant has requested amendment in the import permission issued *vide* letter dated 22.08.2025 to reflect the change in the name of the company from M/s Eswari Global Metal Industries Private Limited to M/s Eswari Global Metal Industries Limited. The applicant has submitted that the change in the name of the company has been approved by the Registrar of Companies and that there is no change in the location or nature of operations of the unit. In support of the request, the applicant has furnished the Certificate of Incorporation consequent upon change of name, updated PAN, and the Consent to Operate and Authorization issued by the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board reflecting the revised company name. Therefore, matter is placed before the Expert Committee for its consideration.

**Recommendation:** Based on the information and details submitted by the applicant, EC recommend to change the name of company from “M/s Eswari Global Metal Industries Private Limited” to “M/s Eswari Global Metal Industries Limited” in the permission granted for import of 19,771 MT of Lead Scrap/Battery Scrap as per ISRI Code: Roper, Rains (A1160) with not more than 2% of liquid/electrolyte by weight in a given lot/consignment/container and Rink (A1160) *vide* letter dated 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2025.

**1.6 M/s Eswari Global Metal Industries Limited - Unit-3, Mangaluru, Karnataka (F.No. 23/109/2023-HSM)**

The applicant has requested amendment in the import permission issued *vide* letter dated 01.04.2026 to reflect the change in the name of the company from M/s Eswari Global Metal Industries Private Limited to M/s Eswari Global Metal Industries Limited. The applicant has submitted that the Registrar of Companies has approved the change in the name of the company and that there is no change in the location or nature of operations of the unit. In support of the request, the applicant has furnished the Certificate of Incorporation consequent upon change of name, updated PAN, and the Consent to Operate and Authorization issued by the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board reflecting the revised company name. Therefore, matter is placed before the Expert Committee for its consideration

**Recommendation:** Based on the information and details submitted by the applicant, EC recommend to change the name of company from “M/s Eswari Global Metal Industries Private Limited” to “M/s Eswari Global Metal Industries Limited” in the permission granted for import of 32,633 MT of Lead Scrap/Battery Scrap (ISRI Code: 'Rinks, Rains, Roper & Racks, Ropes, Rakes, Rents, Radio, Roses, Rono, Relays, Rails, Rabbit, Other lead Waste and Scrap (including lead Grid Crushed lead paste, Lead powder & flakes, lead, in Crushed or powder form) (A1160/B1020) & Rains (A1160) with not more than 2% of liquid/electrolyte by weight in a given lot/consignment/container and Rink (A1160) *vide* letter dated 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2026.

**AGENDA NO. 2: IMPORT OF USED RUBBER/TYRES SCRAP**

## **2.1 Fishfa Rubbers Limited, Rajkot, Gujarat (F.No. 23-80-2014-HSMD)**

The application (App ID-SW0122618262-M014\_D001\_A304-1782229445988) pertains to import of 30,000 MT of old/used rubber tyre scrap/tube scrap (B3140). The applicant has furnished Form 5, Process flow chart indicating adequate pollution control equipment. The Consent to Operate No. and authorization No. AWH-79674 dated 05<sup>th</sup> February, 2025 is valid up to 29<sup>th</sup> December, 2029. The consented capacity for Reclaim and De-polymers Rubbers-2500 MT/M etc. The date of establishment is 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2016. The actual date of operation is 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2016. The production in last FY (FY 2025-26) is 18397.47 MT. The export is 13,809 (FY 2025-26). The unit has connected load of 1850 KVA and respective electricity bill is of Rs. 8,46,89,365.04/- in FY 2025-2026. During FY 2025-2026, The Input Tax Credit (ITC) is 15,67,64,105.58 /- GST Paid is 22,47,83,329.32/-. The domestic purchase was 19351.95 MT out of 19855.60 MT in FY 2025-26. The previous permission was given for the import of 6,000 MT of Used Rubber Tyre/Tube Scrap *vide* letter dated 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2025. The site visit was conducted by CPCB on 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2025.

**Recommendation:** Based on the information/details submitted by the applicant, the EC after deliberation on the proposal, recommended import of 21,470 MT of old/used rubber tyre scrap/tube scrap (B3140) for manufacturing of crumb rubber/reclaim rubber.

## **2.2 M/s VSJ Granurubr Private Limited, Alwar, Rajasthan (F. No. 23-158/2016-HSMD)**

The application (App ID-SW0246694671-M014\_D001\_A304-1779884821620) pertains to import of 29900 MT of old/used rubber tyre scrap/tube scrap (B3080/B3140). The applicant has furnished Form 5, Process flow chart indicating adequate pollution control equipment. The Consent to Operate No. F(Tech)/Alwar(Tijara)/6645(1)/2020/412-413 No. 2020-2021/Bhiwadi/6935 dated 15<sup>th</sup> October 2020 is valid up to 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2030 and Authorization No. F (HSW)/Alwar(Tijara)/7624(1)/2023-2024/766-767 dated 05<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 is valid up to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2028. The consented capacity for Granules - 16,000.00 TPA, Mulch is 7,000.00 TPA, Rubber Strips is 4,500.00 TPA, etc. The date of establishment is 03<sup>rd</sup> June, 2015. The actual date of operation is 01<sup>st</sup> October 2017. The production in last FY (FY 2025-26) is 9525.19 MT. The export is nil (FY 2025-26). The unit has paid electricity bill of Rs. 5,92,686/- in FY 2025-2026. During FY 2025-2026, The IGST is Rs. 1,90,45,111.65, CGST is Rs. 6,96,878.03/-, SGST is 6,96,878.03/- & Total is Rs. 2,04,38,867.71/- The domestic purchase was 2002.25 MT out of 9841.09 MT in FY 2025-26. The previous permission was given for the import of 11,897 MT of Used Rubber Tyre/Tube Scrap *vide* letter dated 19<sup>th</sup> May 2025. The site visit was conducted by CPCB on 22<sup>st</sup> June 2023.

**Recommendation:** Based on the information/details submitted by the applicant, the EC after deliberation on the proposal, recommended import of 6,380 MT of old/used rubber tyre scrap/tube scrap (B3080/B3140) for manufacturing of crumb rubber/reclaim rubber. Further, 50% of the aforesaid recommended quantity (i.e. 3,190 MT) may be granted now and the rest quantity (i.e. 3,190 MT) may be granted after submission of site visit report by CPCB stating compliance of SOP without referring to the EC.

## **2.3 M/s Majestique Carbon LLP, Pune, Maharashtra, (F. No. 23/54/2024-HSM)**

The application (App SW24031190424-M014\_D001\_A304-1782906215229) pertains to import of 5,000 MT of old/used rubber tyre scrap/tube scrap (B3080/ B3140/B3040). The applicant has furnished Form 5, Process flow chart indicating adequate pollution control equipment. The Consent to Operate No. and authorization No. Format1.0/RO/UAN, No. 0000208825/CR/2407000023 dated 01<sup>st</sup> July, 2024 is valid up to 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2030. The consented

capacity for Recycled Carbon Black: 40 MT/Day, Crumb Rubber: 80,000 MT/A, Shredded Steel Scrap: 12,000 MT/A, Fibre: 1000 MT/A, Crumb Rubber Powder: 8500 MT/A, Crumb Rubber Granulates: 4300 MT/A etc. The date of establishment is 27<sup>th</sup> February 2019. The actual date of operation is 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2020. The production in last FY (FY 2025-26) is 3296.06 MT. The export is nil (FY 2025-26). The unit has connected load of 1505 KW and respective electricity bill is of Rs. 1,92,82,074/- in FY 2025-2026. During FY 2025-2026, The Input Tax Credit (ITC) is Rs 7,03,82,442.00/- GST Paid is Rs 96,84,007.00/- The domestic purchase was 3,005.14 MT out of 3,296.06 MT in FY 2025-26. The previous permission was given for the import of 1500 MT of Used Rubber Tyre/Tube Scrap *vide* letter dated 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2024. The site visit was conducted by CPCB on 06<sup>th</sup> October, 2023, and 03<sup>rd</sup> November, 2023.

**Recommendation:** Based on the information/details submitted by the applicant, the EC observed that the Gross GST paid by the applicant appears to be disproportionately high in comparison to the reported production during FY 2025 - 26. Further, applicant was also not present in the meeting to furnish requisite clarification regarding the same. Therefore, EC after deliberation on the proposal recommended that the applicant be asked to submit the requisite clarification. Till then the matter is deferred.

#### 2.4 M/s Parekh Rubber Company, Anand, Gujarat (F.No.23-136/2015-HSMD)

The application (App ID-SW2406933513-M014\_D001\_A304-1783153768449) pertains to import of 15,000 MT of old/used rubber tyre scrap/tube scrap (B3080 & B3140). The applicant has furnished Form 5, Process flow chart indicating adequate pollution control equipment. The Consent to Operate No. and authorization No. AW-42649 dated 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 is valid up to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2035. The consented capacity for Crumb Rubber is 9000 MT/Month etc. The date of establishment is 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2020. The actual date of operation is 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2020. The production in last FY (FY 2025-26) is 17462.76 MT. The export is nil (FY 2025-26). The unit has connected load and respective electricity bill is of Rs. 95,81,650/- in FY 2025-2026. During FY 2025-2026, The Input Tax Credit (ITC) is 6,14,51,417.46/- GST Paid is 7,62,00,120-. The domestic purchase was 11580 MT out of 17462.76 MT in FY 2025-26. The previous permission was given for the import of 9798 MT of Used Rubber Tyre/Tube Scrap *vide* letter dated 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2025. The site visit was conducted by CPCB on 13<sup>th</sup> November, 2024.

**Recommendation:** Based on the information/details submitted by the applicant, the EC after deliberation on the proposal, recommended import of 9,463 MT of old/used rubber tyre scrap/tube scrap (B3080 & B3140) for manufacturing of crumb rubber/reclaim rubber.

#### 2.5 M/s SMP Rubber Mill, Panchmahal, Gujarat (F.No. 23/120/2021-HSM)

The application (App ID-SW2405418030-M014\_D001\_A304-1782990831233) pertains to import of 20,000 MT of old/used rubber tyre scrap/tube scrap (B3140). The applicant has furnished Form 5, Process flow chart indicating adequate pollution control equipment. The Consent to Operate No. and authorization No. W-68965 dated 31<sup>st</sup> January 2024 is valid up to 06<sup>th</sup> April, 2028. The consented capacity for Crumb rubber chips, crumb rubber powder, crumb rubber granules- 1750 MT/M, Crumb rubber powder/granules- 1750 MT/M, Shredded steel scrap (lms light wire scrap) and hms heavy wire scrap), bead wire and fiber- 750 MT/M, Steel wire (by product)-750 MT/M etc. The date of establishment is 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2017. The actual date of operation is 11<sup>st</sup> September, 2017. The production in last FY (FY 2025-26) is 9,302 MT. The export is nil (FY 2025-26). The unit has connected load and respective electricity bill is of Rs. 72,90,500.00/- in FY 2025-2026. During FY 2025-2026, Gross GST is Rs.

151,21,573.51/-, The Input Tax Credit (ITC) is Rs. 1,00,00,585.10/- GST Paid is Rs 51,20,988.41/- The domestic purchase was 6,235 MT out of 9,906 MT in FY 2025-26. The previous permission was given for the import of 4,646 MT of Used Rubber Tyre/Tube Scrap *vide* letter dated 03<sup>rd</sup> June, 2025. The site visit was conducted by CPCB on 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2025.

**Recommendation:** Based on the information/details submitted by the applicant, the EC after deliberation on the proposal, recommended import of 6,201 MT of old/used rubber tyre scrap/tube scrap (B3140) for manufacturing of crumb rubber/reclaim rubber.

## **2.6 M/s Telangana Rubber Industry, Hyderabad, Telangana (F.No. 23-140-2015-HSMD)**

The application (App ID-SW0252153699-M014\_D001\_A304-1783619336286) pertains to import of 30,000 MT of old/used rubber tyre scrap/tube scrap (B3080/B3140). The applicant has furnished Form 5, Process flow chart indicating adequate pollution control equipment. The Consent to Operate No. and authorization No. 1149-RR-II/TPCB.ZOH/CFO-AR/2021-468 dated 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 is valid up to 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2026. The consented capacity for Crumb Rubber: 37,500 MT/PA, Steel Wire: 12,500 MT/PA, etc. The date of establishment is 07<sup>th</sup> May, 2016. The actual date of operation is 07<sup>th</sup> May, 2016. The production in last FY (FY 2025-26) is 23,208.50 MT. The export is Nil (FY 2025-26). The unit has connected load of 350 KVA and respective electricity bill is of Rs. 1,43,89,270.00.00/- in FY 2025-2026. During FY 2025-2026, The Input Tax Credit (ITC) is Rs. 2,95,56,941.00/- GST Paid is 27,19,29,783.00/- . The domestic purchase was 16,157 out of total 24430 MT in FY 2025-26. **Recommendation:** The EC noted that permission for import of 2,750 MT was earlier granted *vide* letter dated 09.08.2024. However, the remaining 50% of the permitted quantity is pending due to non-receipt of the site inspection report from CPCB. In this regard, the EC sought clarification from the applicant. However, the applicant was not present during the meeting to provide the requisite clarification. Therefore, EC requested CPCB to expedite the site inspection to verify the availability of suitable technology/process and compliance with the SOP. Accordingly, the matter was deferred pending receipt of the site inspection report and requisite clarification from the applicant.

The previous permission was granted for import of 6,000 MT of Anode butt vide letter dated 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2025.

The matter was discussed in the 157<sup>th</sup> EC meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2026. Based on the information and details submitted by the applicant, the EC after deliberation on the proposal recommended import of 1200 MT of Anode Butts (Block-Broken-crushed) (B2090), subject to the submission of a chemical analysis report of the waste proposed to be imported, issued by a laboratory accredited or recognized by the exporting country, and thorough verification by the Customs authorities at the time of import.

However, while processing the file, it was noted that the quantity sought by the applicant and recorded in the minutes was incorrectly mentioned as 1200 MT instead of 12,000 MT as submitted by the applicant in Form-5 at NSW portal. The applicant provide the same chemical analysis report as provided at the time of application. In view of the above, the matter is again placed before the EC for further discussion and directions.

Till then the matter is deferred. Thereafter, the CPCB has submitted the report stating that unit is complying with SOP. Thereafter, the matter was again discussed in 154<sup>th</sup> EC meeting held 07<sup>th</sup> March, 2026. The EC after deliberation on the proposal, recommended CPCB to provide clarification as in report it is mentioned that company is partially complying in case of APCD residue while the report is concluded as “Unit is complying with the SOP”. Till then the matter is deferred.

Now, CPCB has submitted the improvement report stating that the unit is now complying with the SOP of MoEF&CC. and hence the matter is placed before EC.

**Recommendation:** Based on the information and details submitted by the applicant, the EC after deliberation on the proposal recommended import of 3,000 Ton of Exhaust Air or Gas cleaning residue (APCD Dust) (A4100). The import of Basel No. A4100 is allowed subject to the Prior Informed Consent (PIC) of the exporting country.
